In accordance with the requirements of the Interstate Commerce Act (the “ICA”) and the regulations of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (the “Commission” or “FERC”), Bengal Pipeline hereby submits for filing FERC No. 19.10.0 (the “Local Rates Tariff”), canceling FERC No. 19.9.0 (Docket Number IS17-64-000). FERC Tariff No. 19.10.0 is being issued on less than one days’ notice, and is proposed to be effective May 19, 2017.

**Explanation of Tariff Filings**

Bengal is filing FERC No. 19.10.0 to provide notice of a temporary embargo for movements originating at Norco Saint Charles Parish, Louisiana or Garyville Saint John the Baptist Parish, Louisiana and delivering to Plantation Pipeline Junction East Baton Rouge Parish (“Plantation”), Louisiana, to perform emergency maintenance on the line. Bengal requests that the embargo remain in effect until a future tariff filing is made cancelling the embargo. All other movements under the proposed tariffs are unaffected by this embargo.

Bengal Pipeline Company is requesting a waiver for notice and tariff requirements under 18 CFR 341.14 and under 6(3) of the ICA in order to have FERC Tariff No. 19.10.0 to be effective May 19, 2017 on less than one days’ notice. Bengal respectfully requests granting of this waiver in order to immediately notify our shippers of the temporary embargo. Bengal acknowledges that

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waivers are granted only for unforeseen circumstances, such as the emergency system integrity maintenance at issue here, and that this tariff publication is conditionally accepted, pending a thirty-day review period.
