Dear Acting Secretary Reese:

In compliance with the Interstate Commerce Act, 49 U.S.C. § 1 *et seq.*, and the Rules and Regulations of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”), 18 C.F.R. Part 341, Bengal Pipeline Company LLC (“Bengal”) hereby submits for filing FERC Nos. 19.24.0 and 20.15.0 (“Index Tariffs”) to be effective July 1, 2025.

I. Explanation of Tariff Filing

Bengal is filing the Index Tariffs in compliance with 18 C.F.R. § 342.3 (Indexing) to increase the rates for services outlined in the Index Tariffs, with such increases to become effective July 1, 2025.
